

5th Annual BCA Cooking Class

Friday-Saturday, February 14-15, 2020 Destrehan Plantation, 13034 River Rd, Destrehan, LA 70047

Get ready for a weekend of some of the best training in barbecue that is available! Participants will be taught techniques by some of the best competition cooks on the Barbecue Competitors Alliance (BCA) circuit for handson classroom and on-site training. BCA is hosting its 5th annual cooking class at the historic Destrehan Plantation (https://www.destrehanplantation.org), which is the oldest documented antebellum plantation home in the lower Mississippi Valley and the closest to New Orleans. There are several hotels located near the plantation for the class.



To celebrate BCA's 5th anniversary, the <u>cost</u> of the 2020 class is <u>\$65 for members</u> or <u>\$100 for non-members</u>. Non-members who register for this course will also become cooking members of BCA for the remainder of 2020.

Competition instructors will share their expertise in all aspects of competition in a BCA-style contest using available barbecue pits and supplies. Each participant will learn the following:

- Contest basics and preparation
- Selecting the best meat
- Tips on using a selection of barbecue pits
- Managing cooking time and temperature under contest conditions
- Cooking techniques from the best competition cooks
- Developing your best flavor profiles
- Preparing your contest turn-in boxes for BCA
 Understanding contest rules and procedures
- Understanding contest rules and procedures
 Learning to prepare the best contest and home barbecue
- How judges evaluate barbecue at contests
- How to interpret scores and what do they really mean.

The objective is to learn to cook better barbecue, both to participate in upcoming contests or for personal enjoyment. This class will be completed rain or shine! Bring a notebook, an open mind, and a willingness to learn! The course is scheduled from 7:00 pm Friday, February 14, 2020 to about 3:45 pm on Saturday, February 15, 2020. Breaks will be taken as the schedule allows. Lunch will be provided as part of the registration fee.
