* For the base formula, the number of paid places will increase or decrease with the number of paid entries down to a minimum of 30 participants. For example, a contest with 40 registered cooks will have a total payout of \$8,700. A minimum of ten places will be paid in each category for 30 to 49 participants. A total of 15 places will be paid in each category for 50 or more registered participants. For contests with less than 30 cooks, the payout will be based on a different formula. For smaller contests, the payout will be \$2,900 for 15 cooks with an additional \$160/cook for 16-29 participants. The payout will be increased if meat costs are small enough to cover all expenses.
